We partnered with WEA Scotland on **Legacies of Resistance to the First World War** adult education project.

We're working with **Campaign Against the Arms Trade** for divestment from arms and an end to arms sales to Saudi Arabia.

Advocating Disarmament

As a partner of the Nobel Peace Prize winning **International Campaign to Abolish Nuclear Weapons** we campaigned for the **UN Treaty on Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons** which entered into force in January 2021.



Our **Peace Cranes** exhibition at the Just Festival in August 2021 exhibits 140,000 origami paper cranes hand crafted by adults and children from Scotland to Japan.

The installation by Janis Hart addresses the existential threats of nuclear weapons and the ecological emergencies.



We campaign with **Don't Bank on the Bomb Scotland** network for divestment from nuclear weapons.
